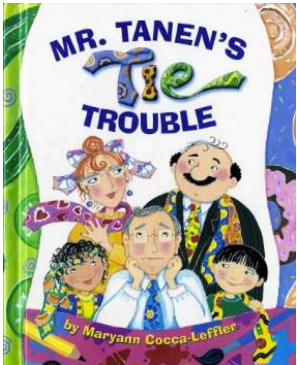
# 100<sup>th</sup> Day Celebration: March 3<sup>rd</sup>
