Target Vocabulary: hairy, litter (of puppies), canned, clipped, stayed, coat (of an animal), chews, mammals

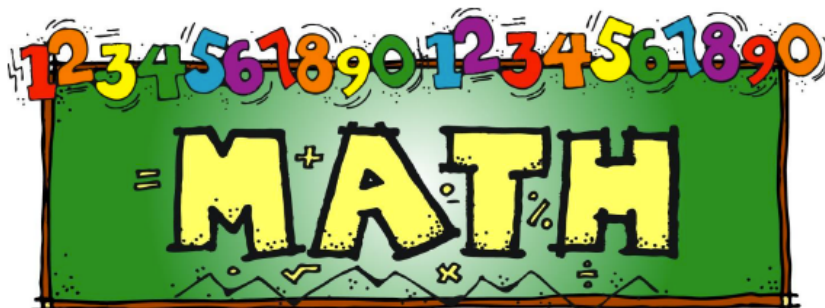
Phonics Skills: Words with long a, (gate), long i (mine) (VCe); hard and soft sounds for c (car, cent)

Vocabulary Strategy: Multiple-meaning words

Comprehension Skill: Author's purpose—tell why an author writes a book

Analyze/ evaluate—tell how you feel about the text and why
