Picture Walk Book Report

2nd Grade March 8, 2024

Materials:

- -construction paper (size should be IIXI8 I piece will be provided.)
- -art supplies such as, (but not limited to) crayons, colored pens, colored pencils, scissors

Procedure:

For this book report you need to choose a book that is a <u>chapter book</u>. It should not be a graphic novel. It should be a book that is at or around the child's current reading level. It should not be a book that student has previously read.

It's nice to take a walk to look at interesting things. Better yet is when you walk with a friend, and you get to show him or her something you really think is great. For this book report, you are going to take the class on a walk through your book. Your job is to let the class see the story as you saw it. Your presentation should be between I to 2 minutes. Please practice at home.

At the top, write your name, the title, the author's name, and the publisher's name. Lengthwise across your paper, draw lines that look something like the ones in the example at the bottom of the page.

Think of the key points in the story that you read. You will be drawing in the boxes, and should make 4 boxes, (Beginning, Middle, Next, End) of the story. Use a full piece of construction paper for your report.



In each section, draw a picture of your favorite point or event. <u>Do not write</u> words under the picture. This picture should be bold and bright. Start with light pencil lines and make the picture take up most of the available room.

Next, color your drawings.

A good way to check what you've done is to look at your picture from across the room. Can you easily read it? Does it look interesting? Are the pictures too small? This helps you see what others see.

Write a report about your book.

The first paragraph should be written like a paragraph, not a list of information. It should include the title, author, name of publisher, and the number of pages. Also, include whether the book is from home, school, or the public library.

In the next part you will write 2 or 3 sentences about each part of the story. Give **details** about each part. The second part of your report should consist of 4 paragraphs. One paragraph for each part/box. This means that your report should have 6 paragraphs. The last paragraph is a recommendation.

Preapproval form and scoring rubric are available on class website. Preapproval form is due on **February 23, 2024**.

You will need to bring the following to school:

1) Picture Walk Poster 2) Book and 3) Book report

The book report should be in 2ndgrade appropriate language and should be hand written by the student. Parents may choose to type the report, in addition to the written report, so that the student may use the typed report in their presentation, but a typed report in not mandatory.
