**Writing:** This week we will finish our Bio Poems and then begin working on our life maps for our autobiographies. A life map is a visual representation of the major events in our lives.

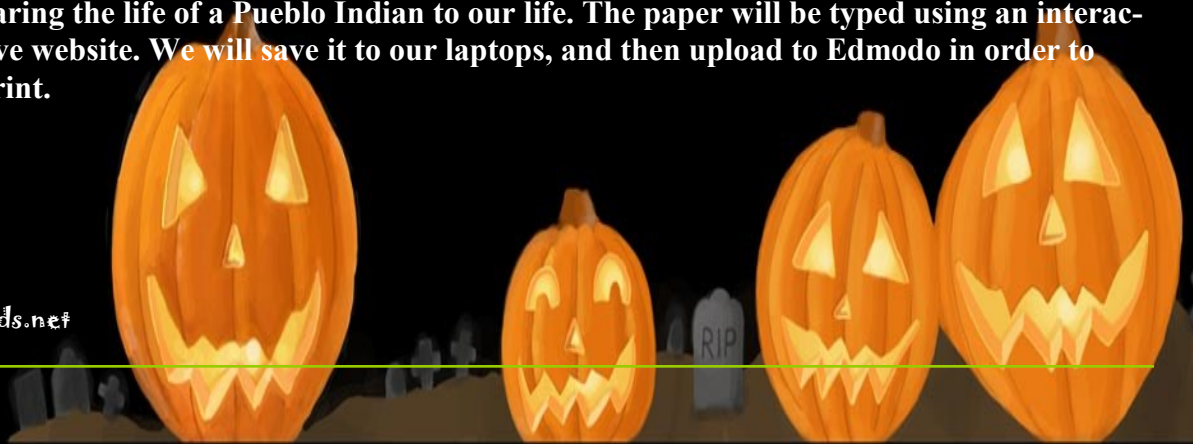
