## COM ARTS

**Word Study:** This week we work on Unit 3 Part 2. Monday we will read "The Missing Doughnuts" and complete pages 54-55. Tuesday we will do pages 56-57. Wednesday we will complete pages 58. On Thursday we will complete page 59 and review. Friday will be our spelling and meanings tests as usual. Next week we will complete pages 60-64. There will be no spelling/meaning test during the week of October 22 due to the short week.

**Reading:** This week we will begin *Charlotte's Web*. We will read chapter 1 on Monday, chapters 2-3 on Tuesday, chapters 4-5 on Wednesday, and chapter 6 on Thursday. We will complete journaling about friendship and illustrate a favorite scene. Next week (October 22), we will read chapters 7-8. We will then work on our blow art monsters for our cinquain poem.

**Writing:** We will finish our Halloween stories this week, and then begin to work on our cinquain monster poems for this week and next. We will also use writing time to create our blow art monsters to accompany our poems.

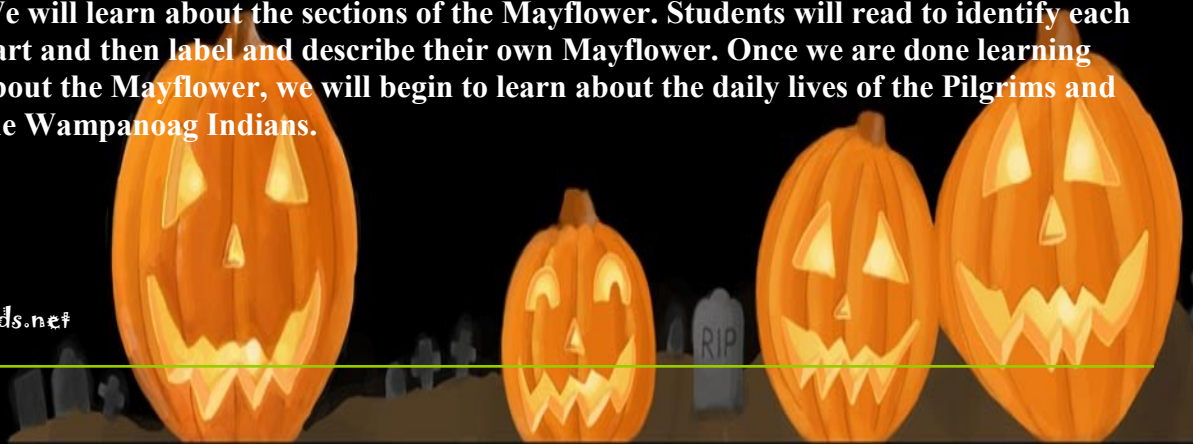
**Cursive:** During the next two weeks we will practice the lowercase letters of h, f, k, r, s and j.

## MATH

During the next week and a half, we will finish up chapter 3 and subtraction. This week we will work with 3-digit subtraction (Monday), 4-digit subtraction (Tuesday), subtracting across zero (Wednesday), estimating differences (Thursday), and problem solving (Friday). Next week we will review, take our fluency test on Tuesday, and our core math test on Wednesday.

## SOCIAL STUDIES

During this next week and a half we will learn about the Pilgrims journey to America. We will learn about the sections of the Mayflower. Students will read to identify each part and then label and describe their own Mayflower. Once we are done learning about the Mayflower, we will begin to learn about the daily lives of the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag Indians.
