Word Study: We will continue unit 4 during this week. This week we will work with Unit 4 Part 2. On Monday we will read "Desert Plants" on page 76 and complete our context strategy on page 77. Tuesday we will work pages 78-79, and on Wednesday we will complete pages 80. On Thursday we will complete page 81 and play a review game. Friday will be the tests as usual.

Reading: We will finish *Charlotte's Web* this week. Monday we will work on identifying main idea and supporting details, and Tuesday we will learn about inferencing as we prepare to write our paper about friendship using details from *Charlotte's Web*.

Writing: This week we will begin preparing to write our *Charlotte's Web* paper. Monday and Tuesday we will begin talking about the friends who appear in the book and identify how we know they are friends (ie. They *help* each other). Then students will find supporting details from the book to explain how the friends demonstrate that characteristic of friendship (ie, Charlotte talks to Wilbur so he won't be lonely). They will also identify a friend of theirs and write two paragraphs explaining how they know that person is their friend.




