

Word Study: We will not begin word study this week. On Friday, we will hold a practice test using second grade words so that students learn the format of the tests. Words to be used are on page two of the newsletter. We will begin Word Study next week. **Remember**, this year spelling is not the only goal; students must also know the meaning of the words based on content the word is used in.



Reading: During reading time this week we will be doing some introductory activities and go over classroom expectations. We will also work on setting up our laptops and learning some standard procedures. We will get our login information for a variety of programs to be used, and learn the expectations for using the computers. We will also begin some general assessments. **Writing:** We will do a variety of writing projects this week. We will write about a favorite summer activity. Tuesday we will work on fall about me pager? for our writing compared to writing also.


Cursive: We will begin handwriting on Thursday. The first unit in cursive is a review of manuscript. I will also be showing students how we assess cursive writing.



This week we will take an assessment test on Tuesday. The rest of the week we will review math facts, take a couple of timed tests on basic facts to establish a baseline, and do some review of second grade concepts.



We will use Social Studies time to work on introductory activities, practice routines for academic subjects, read Time for Kids and National Geographic, and complete beginning week projects as needed.
