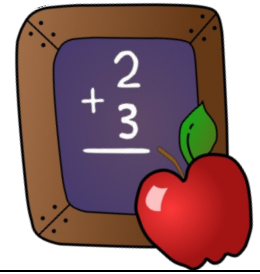

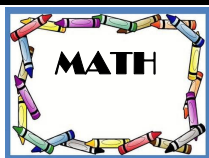

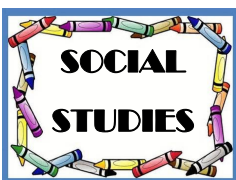
**Reading:** We will finish Freckle Juice this week. We will also take the SRI test during reading, and begin fluency assessments.

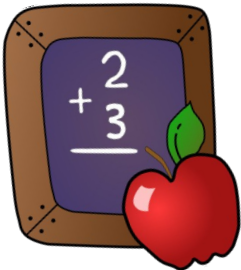

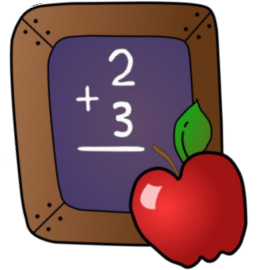
